



Proof of Immunization against MMR and Tdap

Step 1: Locate your proof of immunization against:

- Measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR)
- Tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis (Tdap) within the last 10 years

If you have proof of the above immunizations, you've completed this requirement. If you have not received MMR and/or Tdap immunization(s), skip to **Step 4**.

Step 2: If you do not have your immunization record, you may be able to get an electronic record by completing an Immunization Record Request.

Step 3: If your immunization record is not available, you can get a blood test that proves immunization, known as a titer test, at your doctor's office or a <u>test location near you</u>.

Step 4: If you need either vaccine, local pharmacies, including <u>Walgreens</u>, <u>CVS</u>, <u>Rite Aid</u>, and urgent care facilities frequently offer them. Be sure to request an immunization record before leaving.

Step 5: Save your immunization record to submit with your license application.
